As a reminder, law enforcement, or any State or Federal Agency will never ask for money in via phone, or email . Payment is due by March 22, 2026, with processing scheduled for March 23, 2026.

If this issue is not resolved by the deadline, actions will be taken under State Regulation 12C-16.003, which may include:

- First, suspension of your vehicle license.
- Second, temporary suspension of your driving privileges (up to 4 business days).
